Adding **-est** to words ending in **e**

When we add the suffix **-est** to words ending in **e**, we only need to add **-st**, as the **e** is already there.

nice → **nicest**

Adding **-y** to words ending in **e**

When we add the suffix **-y** to words ending in **e**, we remove the **e** before adding the **-y**.

shine → **shiny**

This week, we have been looking at the difference between statements and exclamations.



- A **statement** is a type of sentence which tells you something. It contains a **verb** and ends with a **full stop**.

The girl was **singing** in the hall.

- An **exclamation** is another type of sentence. It must start with **what** or **how**, contain a verb and end with an **exclamation mark**.
