Specialist PE coaching	£6866	Weekly sessions with a qualified PE coach for three year groups	Improved teacher confidence and pupil engagement in PE
After-school clubs	£1485	Extra curricular clubs run by staff	Enhanced quality of PE lessons and broader curriculum coverage
Equipment purchase	£200	New sports equipment including athletics kits and playground games	Increased participation in break-time physical activity
Swimming provision	£1711	Top-up swimming lessons for KS1 pupils	90% of pupils met national curriculum swimming requirements

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After-school clubs	£7866	Sports clubs run by external providers	Increase in pupil participation in extracurricular sport. Enables a broad range of clubs.
