Universal Infant Free School Meals Provision & FSM

All Key Stage One children are entitled to a free school meal every day. To confirm our records are up to date and ensure we receive the valuable funding for this process, please complete the application form online using the following link: [Free school meals – Herefordshire Council](#) and click on apply for free school meals. If you would prefer, please contact the office who will provide you with a short form to fill out and the office will return it to Council. This process will help the school ensure that pupil premium funding is correctly allocated.

If you feel you may be eligible we would ask that you put in the application this week, as the additional funding for the school is allocated at the beginning of October each year.

Free school meals are available to any family in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400 which accounts to £616.67 per month
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Child Tax Credit – with no Working Tax Credit – with an annual income of no more than £16,190
- Additionally, families with no recourse to public funds are now eligible to claim for free school meals subject to maximum income thresholds.
