

# How to do your Quizzing Homework

Select a part of the knowledge organizer to create a quiz from – it should only be 8 – 10 pieces of information, do not select more than this

You can create more than one question from a piece of information



Read and re-read the section of the knowledge organizer



Use your knowledge organizer to write questions and answers.

After 10 minutes of writing your 8-10 questions and answers, fold the answers underneath so you can't see them.



Try to answer the questions in your head.

Check the answer if you can't remember, 'take a sneaky peek'.



Write the answers



Check and correct the answers in green pen

## Examples of questions you could use

1. **What is the definition of a verb?**
2. **What does the body use carbohydrates for?**
3. **List the sources of carbohydrates**
4. **Who was Romeo Montague?**
5. **How are elements grouped together?**
6. **When was the Domesday Book written?**

## You can turn each of these questions around:

1. **What term is used for writing arranged in short lines with a regular rhythm?**
2. **Which nutrient provides energy for the body?**
3. **Cereals, bread, pasta, rice and potatoes are sources of which nutrient?**
4. **Which Character in Romeo and Juliet was intense, intelligent, quick-witted and loved by his friends?**
5. **What are grouped according to their properties in the periodic table?**
6. **Which historical document was written in 1085?**
