Proposed Disposal of Land at Stokesley Primary Academy
Section 77 Schools Standards and Framework Act 1998

I am writing to you as part of a consultation process to enable North Yorkshire County Council to seek consent from the Secretary of State to dispose of playing field land which is located at Stokesley Primary Academy. To comply with Section 77 of the Schools Standards and Framework Act 1998, the Council must seek views from various interested parties to include the Academy, Governing Body, parents/guardians of pupils attending the School, neighbouring Schools within one mile, District and Town Councils, also the local County Councillor, MP and local community generally.

The area under consideration is shown shaded pink on the attached plan and measures in the region of 1,065m². Any redevelopment of this area would require planning permission and as such would be subject to a separate consultation and approval process.

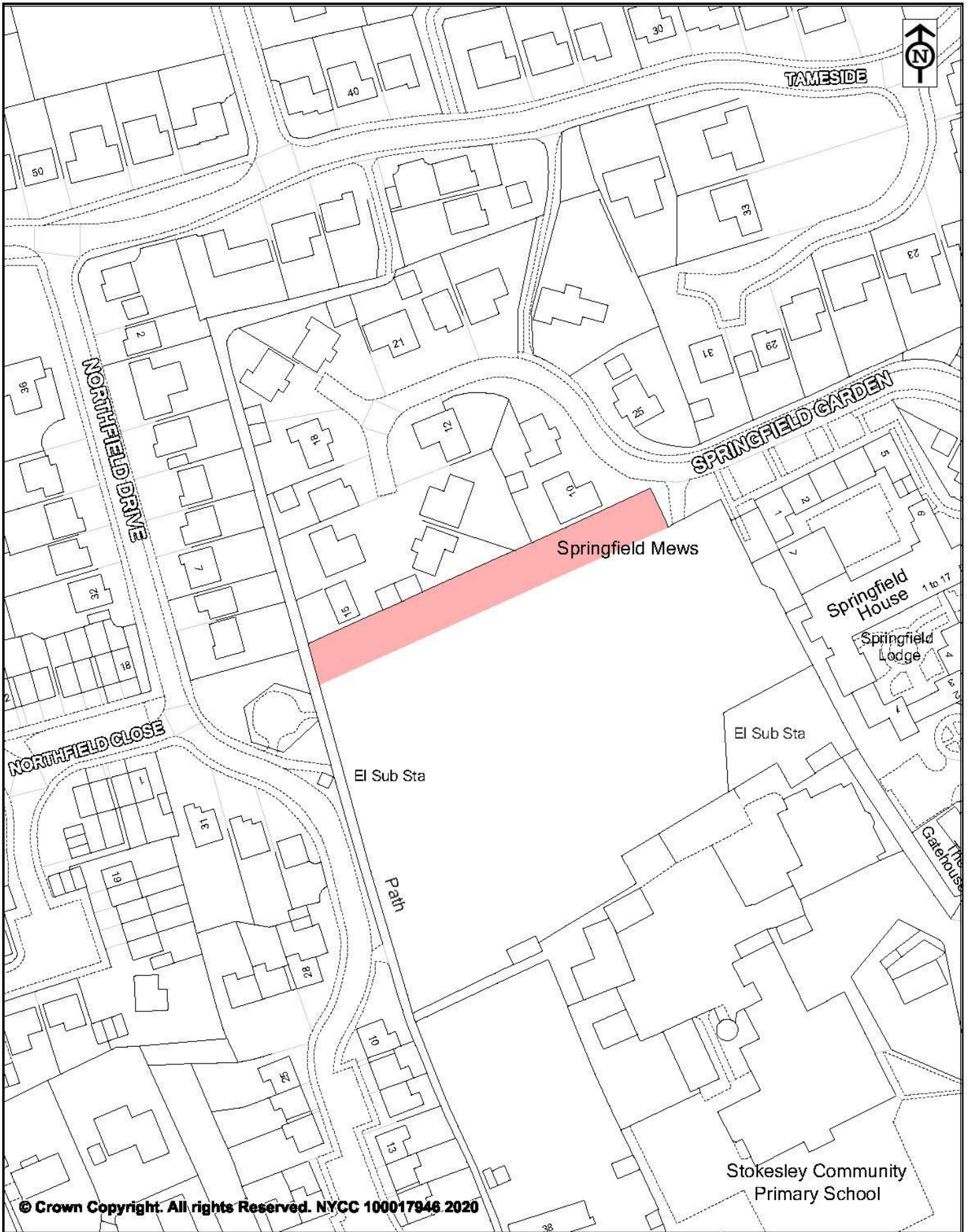
