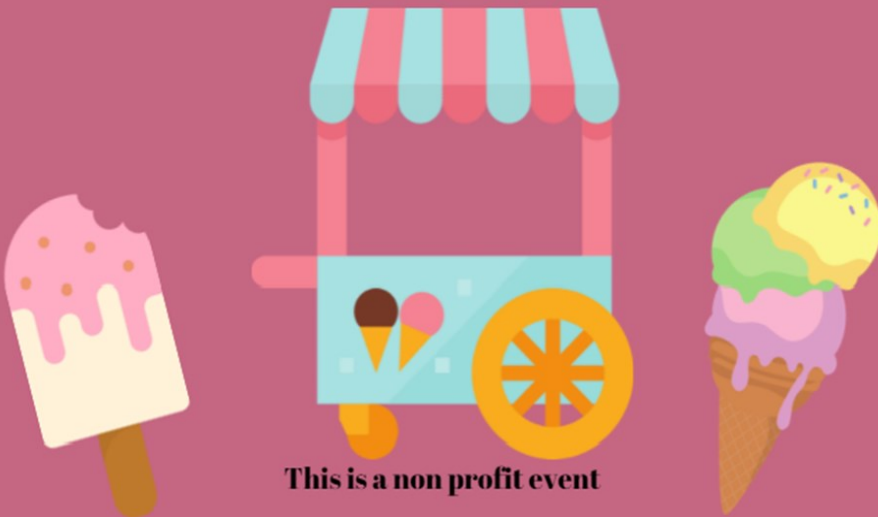


Ice cream day Friday 9th July






