WELCOME BACK

Dear Parents

A warm welcome back to school following the half-term holiday, I hope you all enjoyed your Autumn break, despite the restrictions. Please find following information on what we have planned for this next half-term.

COVID

We have been very fortunate last half-term to have had little impact on our class bubbles, however, as case numbers are increasing I fully expect we will have to close a bubble, at some point. If and when this is the case you will be contacted via email with the relevant information. I would like to thank you for your co-operation during this difficult time, isolating where necessary and keeping us updated. As we are going into another lockdown and safety is our priority we need to ensure our procedures are as tight as possible. Please see below our updated guidance to be followed at all times:

- One parent/carer only to accompany pupil at drop off and pick up times
- Children to stay with adult at all times and not to run or walk ahead at drop off and pick up times
- Adults to wear a mask when approaching school, on the playground and at the school reception/office
- Social distancing on the playground and keeping a 2m distance from the classroom door at drop off and pick up times
- Teachers may wear a mask at the door when greeting pupils and parents
- KS1 school lunches to be served in the hall at staggered times, bubbles will be socially distanced
- KS2 school lunches will continue to have their lunch in the classroom

Please note from THUR 5 NOV access via the Y.M.C.A. will NOT be available during the lockdown period.






