Welcome back to the Spring Term!

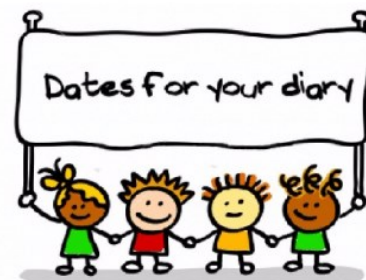
