Thinking ahead to after half term, we have several opportunities for our children to shine. It is that time of year where we are finalising budgets and making difficult decisions as to where we may need to make cuts or re-think our plans. As you know we have our Building Fund, which, like all Catholic schools in the area, we ask parents to contribute to. This makes a huge difference and helps us to pay the annual £4,600 bill we receive from the Diocese. So far this year we have received £1,340, a big thank you for your generous donations. If you have not already paid a contribution, we ask you to do this by the end of the school year. Our next building project is scheduled to start over the school summer break, alongside the refurbishment of Year 5 classroom, new carpets in Year 1 and 2 and various new windows.

The Coastal Collective is a charity of which I, and all the local Heads in the Lytham St Annes area, are Trustees. It is funded for the next five years via a generous donation from The Lytham School Foundation. This support is to help the schools support children who have additional needs or may need social and emotional support. This vital funding means that we are able to provide a little more for all our children, as we are able to redirect funds that would otherwise have to be spent on this specialist provision. We feel incredibly privileged and grateful. We are currently waiting for a sensory circuit to be delivered, funded by The Collective, which will benefit all our children.
