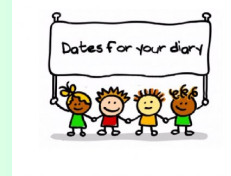
In year 4 we looked at diversity, what it is and how bright our world is because it and we are so diverse. Children have been popping into show me their work which has been brilliant.

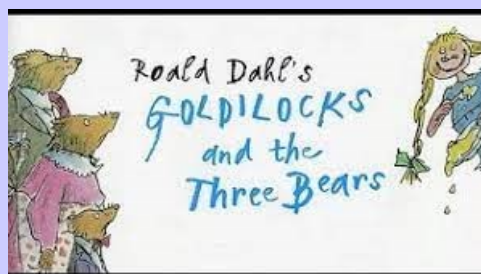

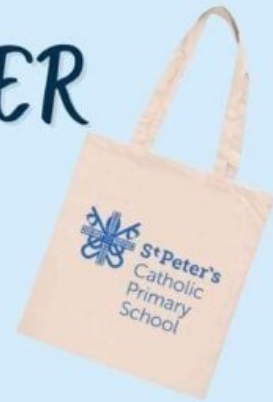
