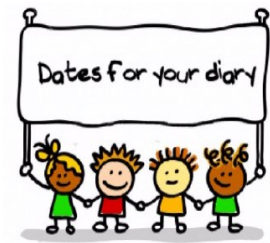

### COVID Guidelines

The KS1 children will be taking part in Nativity liturgies in their class bubbles, which we will also share with the school community. Further information to follow.



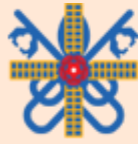
