### FREE SCHOOL MEALS INFORMATION

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to universal free school meals. ### THINK CRITICALLY

The key to addressing the increasing growth of AI-enabled scams is to think critically and show caution. Inform children that if semething is to good to be true, then it probably is. Incourage them is stop and carefully consider what they are seeing and reading before taking any action. For example, if a male.
