FREE SCHOOL MEALS INFORMATION

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to universal free school meals. However, some families who are on low income and meet a certain criteria, are also eligible for supermarket shopping vouchers during school holidays and free holiday club places. Eligible families will continue to receive free school meals after Year 2.

Some families with children in Key Stage 1 do not claim as they are already getting free school meals, however they are missing out on the other benefits so please double check.

We're pleased to let you know that we now have a battery recycling box located in the school entrance.

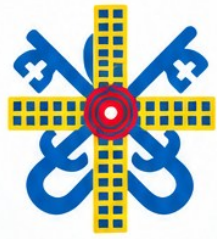


Should My Child Stay Off School?

Who are Enso?

Our mission is to encourage our students, whatever their age or ability, to gain confidence, empowering them to push themselves further than they ever imagined. Using teamwork, discipline and fun to engage students, giving them the physical skills and mental toughness to take on any challenge they set themselves.

All of our senior instructors are fully insured, have an enhanced DBS certificate and are trained in paediatric first aid and safeguarding.

What are the costs?

Our weekly lessons cost £7.95 per session. Fees are due 6 times a year, by the end of the first week of each half term. You will be emailed an invoice with the details before each half term starts.

We usually hold gradings 3 times per year at the cost of £32. These are not compulsory, your child will be invited by letter if your instructor thinks they are ready to take this examination.

We refer to our Ju Jitsu uniform as a 'kimono' or 'gi'. These can be purchased from your instructor, the cost of our uniform is £44. There is no need to buy a uniform immediately, we would recommend that you wait until you know your child is going to continue with classes.
