




encourage your child to keep jumpers and any other items in their bags, if taken off.

If it is an emergency call 999 or go to the emergency department (A&E). Our text number does not receive

In your need help bende you hear back non do, contact you repartment (A&E). Our text number does not receive voice calls or MMS picture messages. We support messaging from UK mobile numbers only (which does not include messages sent from landlines, international mobile numbers and some 'number masking' mobile apps). To prevent the health professional from sending messages to you, text STOP to our number.
