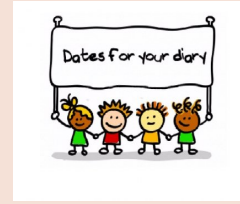

The PTFA are sponsoring this activity

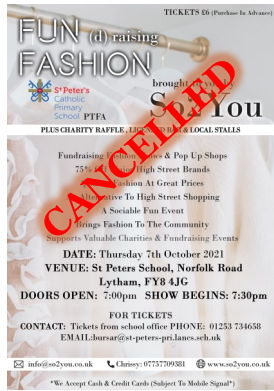
