

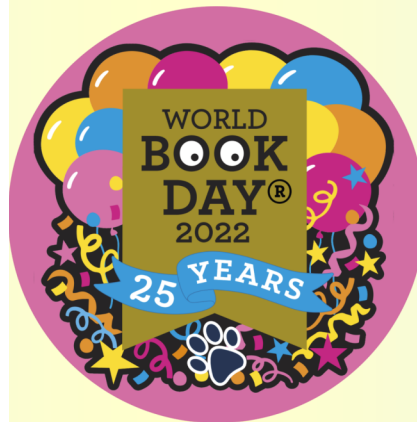
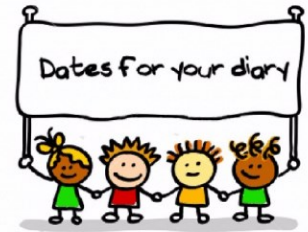

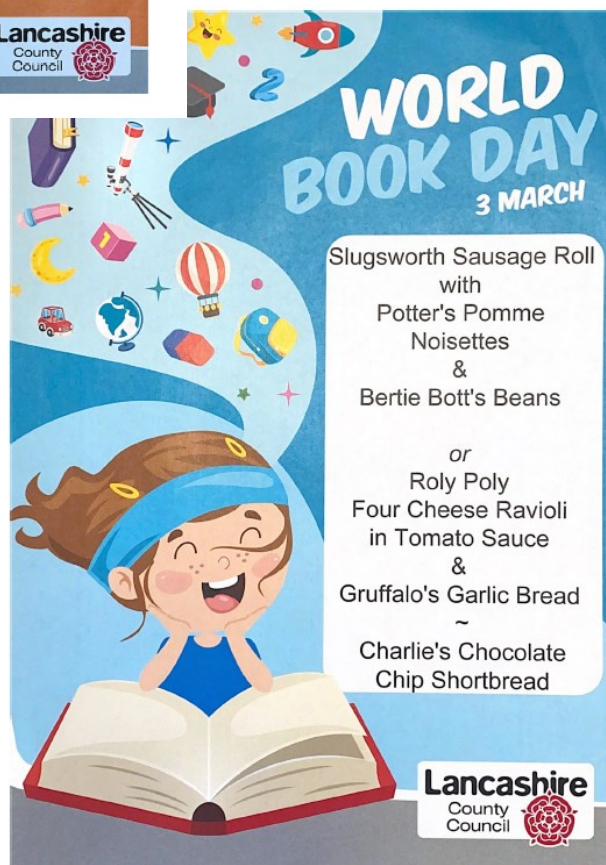
Celebrating 25 years of World Book Day

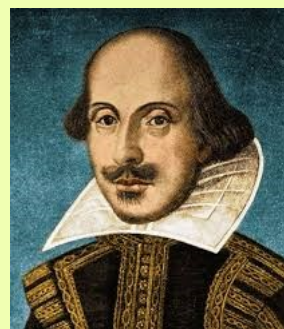
