Please note all accounts must be up to date to ensure your child's place for the following half term. Please check account balances online via Scopay or enquire at the school office.

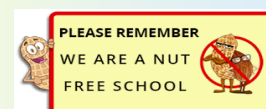

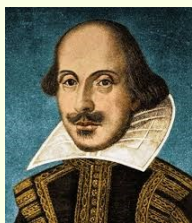
Spring school reports maybe slightly delayed, due to staff absences. Please be assured you should receive by Thurs 7th April, via email.

THINK PINK FOR ALEX!

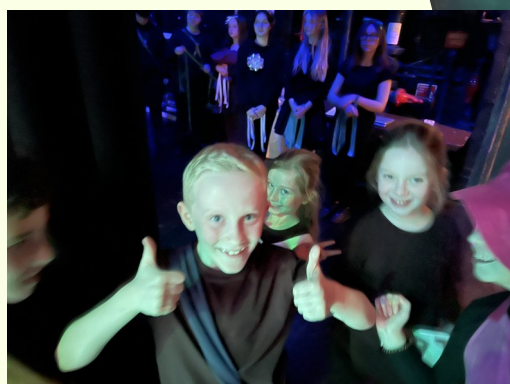
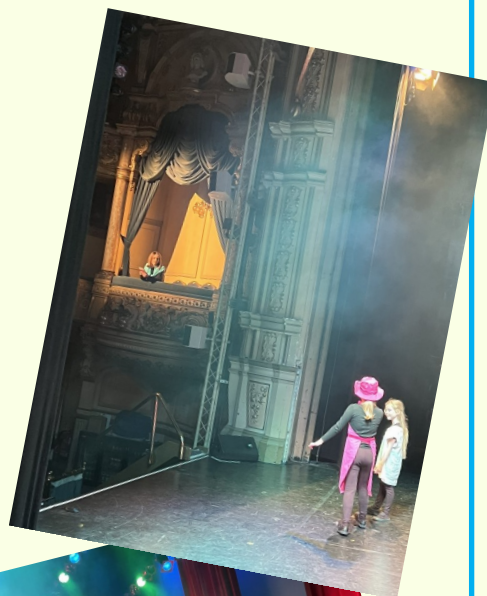
