

Dear Parent/Carer

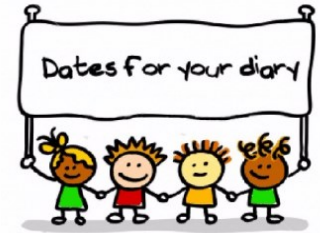

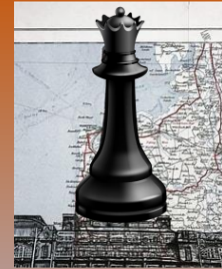
