



Autumn 2 in Reception

Phonics

Children will work daily within their Read Write Inc (RWinc) group where they will continue to learn and revise Set 1 sounds (the 26 alphabet sounds plus sh, th, ch, ng, nk). Children will learn to form these letters correctly when writing and blend these sounds to read and write words. Once they can read and blend sounds orally, they will bring home a Phonics Book Bag reader which is linked to work they do in school.

Maths

We will learn:

- 2D & 3D shapes
- Number bonds to 5
- Spatial Awareness

Understanding the World

We will learn:

- About different celebrations including Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day, Advent and Christmas.
- Continue to notice seasonal changes, linked with exploring freezing and melting.
- Christmas in other countries.

Expressive Art and Design

Children will have opportunities to explore creative activities including using paint to create different effects and colour mixing. They will continue to explore making counts with their voices and musical instruments and will learn songs for our Christmas Nativity. Children will have opportunities for role play linked with their experiences and as part of our Nativity play preparations.



RE

We will explore the creation story. We will learn about Advent as a time of preparing ourselves for Christmas and we will learn about the Christmas story.

HRSE

We will learn that we are created by God and loved by God.

Physical Development

Continue to refine the fundamental movements skills during outdoor provision and PE lessons: catching, running, hopping, jumping, throwing.

Develop finger strength and fine motor control.



PSHE

Continue to embed school rules and routines. Develop independence skills. Learning to build respectful relationships with adults and peers.

Speaking and Listening

Using talk through story time children will develop attention, listening and communication skills. They will be introduced to new vocabulary through the stories we share. They will be encouraged to join in with favourite stories and supported to use new vocabulary in the talk.
