



Spring 2 in Reception

Phonics

Children will work daily within their Read Write Inc (RWinc) group where they will continue to learn and revise Set 1 sounds (the 26 alphabet sounds plus sh, th, ch, ng, nk). Children will learn to form these letters correctly when writing and blend these sounds to read and write words. Children will bring home a reading book which will help consolidate their work in phonics.

Children will begin to read and write short captions and sentences using their phonic knowledge and recognise and write some "red words".

Maths

We will:

- Compare numbers within 10 using "more than", "fewer than" and equal to", recognising that the size and colour of objects is irrelevant to the quantity
- Develop and understanding of doubles, equal parts and even numbers
- Explore measures including length and weight

Understanding the World

We will:

- learn about people in our communication who help us
- Notice seasonal changes in our natural world



RE

We will learn about Lent and how Catholic Christians behave and why. Saying sorry and forgiveness. The events of Holy Week and Easter.

HRSE

Created to Love Others: we will explore our relationships with others and how we develop healthy and safe relationships with friends and family.

PSHE

Through HRSE: Safe and happy relationships and people who help us

Physical Development

Continue to refine the fundamental movements skills during outdoor provision and PE lessons: catching, running, hopping, jumping, throwing.

Learn how we keep ourselves safe and healthy.



Speaking and Listening

As we continue to use talk through story time children will develop attention, listening and communication skills. They will be introduced to new vocabulary through the stories we share. They will be encouraged to join in with favourite stories and supported to use new vocabulary in the talk.
