# Summer 2 in Reception

## Phonics

Children will work daily within their Read Write Inc (RWinc) group where they will continue to learn and revise Set I and Set 2 sounds. Children will continue to practise forming these letters correctly when writing.

Children will bring home a reading book which will help consolidate their work in phonics.

Children will begin to read and write short captions and sentences using their phonic knowledge and recognise and write some "red words".

### Maths

#### We will:

- Learn to use rekenrek to support subitising.
- Use subitising tools and 10 frames to help to recall number bonds to 5 and
   10.
- Revise and deepen understanding of patterns in numbers including doubling, sharing, odd and even numbers

# Understanding the World We will:

- learn to indentify some features of where we live
- identify similarities between our country and other countries
- recognise animals that live in hot and cold places

#### RF

We will hear how Jesus called the first disciples.

That we are helping to build God's world and everyone's gifts are needed. We will learn how St. Peter's became the first pope. We will begin to learn some of the key parts and symbolism in the Mass.

Expressive Arts and Design

Explore using different items to make prints.

Use printing effects to create African animal inspired artwork.

## Physical Development

Continue to refine the fundamental movements skills during outdoor provision and PE lessons: catching, running, hopping, jumping, throwing. Prepare for and take part in Sports Day.



## Speaking and Listening

As we continue to use talk through story time children will develop attention, listening and communication skills. They will be introduced to new vocabulary through the books we share, including non-fiction texts.
