UNIFORM

Item	Special Feature	Colour
BLAZER		Brown with school badge
SKIRT	Kilt, pleated, A-Line	Brown

Skirts should be mid-knee to mid-calf in length. If you have difficulty finding a skirt that fits correctly in the waist but is too short, some of our uniform suppliers will order skirts made-to-measure.

(Short straight skirts with splits are not allowed)

TROUSERS	To match blazer	Dark brown (with pockets and a button – No Leggings)
SHIRT	Short or long sleeved formal with top button not casual	White
JUMPER (Optional)	Brown 'V' neck (optional) (from uniform suppliers only)	With red/yellow stripe
TIE	Clip on	Brown with red/yellow stripe
SOCKS	Plain ankle socks (No long White Socks)	White (with skirts) Dark brown (with trousers)
TIGHTS	Ribbed/Plain (during cold weather)	Plain brown
SHOES	Simple sturdy flat-heeled school shoes Must have a strap, boots are allowed but only with trousers (not with skirts)	Plain dark brown or black.

(Ballet, striped or trainer style shoes are not allowed. Please see the images on the website for examples)

It is advisable to have a School hoodie during the winter months.
Pupils will be allowed to wear tracksuit bottoms (in bad weather conditions) at the teacher's discretion.

OUTDOOR WEAR FOR PUPILS IF REQUIRED

School outdoor coat/fleece, Scarves gloves, caps etc are fine.

JEWELLERY

Because we feel that it will constitute a danger in some lessons, we do not allow the wearing of jewellery in school, except for a wristwatch if required.

HAIR

Hair should be kept neat and tidy and of one natural colour.

The school reserves the right to prohibit unsuitable fashions/styles. If you are unsure of what is acceptable please contact the school in advance of getting a particular hairstyle/cut.

Hair of one natural colour, no extreme fashion styles (Mullet / Mohican, Top Knots etc), accessories must be plain black or brown, no stepped or sudden changes in length sides or back, no bullet creases or patterns shaved in, no 'skin fades' and not to be shorter than number 1 sides & back, clean shaven.

Hair bands/accessories should be discreet and brown or black.

(Compulsory for Y7-Y10)

**Clip on Tie**

Compulsory

Y7-10 striped

Y11 brown with motif

**Jumper**

Y7-10 Optional Item - preferred school brown jumper with striped neck. Option of a plain brown v neck jumper can also be purchased.

Y11 Jumper - compulsory instead of a Blazer.

**White Shirt**
Compulsory.

Tucked in, top button fastened



Trousers must have a button and pockets, brown socks to be worn

Brown Trousers or Skirt

(Knee length)

Worn with plain brown tights or plain white ankle socks.

**Black/Brown School Shoes**

No trainers, pumps or ballet shoes.

See website for details. Black/Brown ankle boots can be worn with trousers only.
