

## YEAR 2 AUTUMN TERM

### MOVERS AND SHAKERS

#### Computing

In Computing children will be learning about computer networks, online safety and programming.

#### Art

Children learn about the work of significant still life artists and still life techniques. They create still life arrangements and artwork.

#### Science

Children will learn about the basic needs of humans for survival, including the importance of exercise, nutrition and good hygiene. They will then learn about habitats and what a habitat needs to provide.

#### Religious Education (RE)

Children will be learning about The Sikh wedding ceremony that is called the Anand Karaj. They will then explore Christmas and Advent.

#### Geography

This essential skills and knowledge project teaches children about atlases, maps and cardinal compass points. They also compare England to Somalia.

#### History

This project teaches children about historically significant people who have had a major impact on the world. They will learn to use timelines, stories and historical sources to find out about the people featured and use historical models to explore their significance.

#### DT

This project teaches children about sources of food and tools used for food preparation. The children choose and make a new school meal that fulfils specific design criteria.

#### Music

We will explore South African Style music, as well as Big Band and Motown.

#### PSHE

Children will discuss the questions 'What is the same and different about us?' And 'How can we look after each other and our world?'.

#### Physical Education (PE)

During PE we will revisit the fundamental skills of PE, as well as developing our yoga and dance skills.
