Summer a – what grows around me?

Summer b – where can we explore?

Communication & Language

We will continue to learn new words to expand our vocabulary.

Use sentences when talking to others.

Sing a range of songs.

Listen to stories and answer why questions about what we have heard.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development and PSHE

We will talk about our feelings and how our actions can affect others.

We will support our transition to reception by having circle times to talk about what going to Reception will be like.

We will play in the Reception classrooms and look at areas of the school we haven't been to before, for example the dining hall.

Music

As musicians we will explore the sounds we can make with percussion instruments. We will look at making loud, quiet sounds and fast and slow rhythms.

Expressive Arts & Design

As artists we will draw and paint animals and objects talking about the shapes that we use.

We will continue to develop our storytelling skills and use construction toys and characters to create 'small worlds.'

Physical Development

As athletes we will be moving in a range of ways and using our knowledge to create simple games.

We will use our fine motor skills to write letters from our name.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will secure our knowledge of numbers to 5, including identifying the numerals, subitising and making arrangements of numbers.

Understanding the World

As scientists we will explore what plants and seeds need to grow.

We will also investigate forces that we can feel.

As geographers we will talk about different countries in the world and look at photos of different places.

Literacy

We will be sharing stories and talking about the characters and events in the stories.

We will be finding rhyming words and initial sounds to support our learning in phonics.

We will be using this knowledge in our early writing when we will begin to write letters in our play.

Phonics

We will be using our listening skills to hear initial sounds in words. We will also be hearing sounds in words and blending them together.
