Communication & Language

We will continue to develop our confidence when speaking in whole class discussions, as well as listening and responding to the views of others. Using the correct tense, we will recall previous experiences and develop our questioning towards the world around us.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development and PSHE

We will discuss how we maintain a healthy body and lifestyle by eating a balanced diet, having regular movement and getting plenty of sleep. We will also cover oral hygiene and when we should take medicines.

Music

As musicians, our topics are Everyone & Our World. We will listen to pieces of music from a range of artists from around the world. We will also use glockenspiels each lesson to find the beat to a range of nursery rhymes.

Expressive Arts & Design

As artists and creators, we will use a range of media to create pictures related to our topics.

We will also develop our deconstructed role play to support our imaginations when acting out different professions.

Physical Development

Our PE focuses this term will be fundamental and gymnastics. Through a range of games and activities, we will explore different types of movement using new pieces of equipment. This will all contribute to the development of our gross and fine motor skills.

Understanding the World

As explorers of our world, we will look at people in our community to help us in important ways. We will then look back to explore what happened long ago, using a timeline to support our understanding of what happened in our lifetime, and before.

Math

As mathematicians, we will explore groups of more, less and equal amounts. We will also develop our understanding of numbers 5-10 through comparison and looking at the part and whole of each number.

Literacy

Using our phonics knowledge, we will use our newly learnt digraphs and trigraphs to write sentences with 4+ words.

Phonics

We will learn 11 digraphs and 3 trigraphs this term. We will also learn to read compound words, words with 2 digraphs, and words ending in –ing.
