Our Vision

Our Wraparound Provision



At Strathmore we provide wraparound care for our pupils from 7.45am until 5.45pm. This includes the following options:

- Breakfast club: 7:45am 8:45am
- Nursery Lunch Club: 11:45am 12:45pm
- After school provision: 3:15pm 5:45pm

All of our sessions are run by staff trained and employed directly by the school.

Our vision is to ensure our pupils feel welcome, safe, happy and respected in each provision on offer. Children should feel like this time is an extension to their school day and have an opportunity to socialise and continue to build relationships with pupils and staff. Our wraparound vision is closely linked to our whole school vision which can be found on our <u>website</u>.

In order to ensure all our attendees have access to a range of activities that suit all their needs, we spend time talking to our pupils to discuss their interests and likes on a regular basis.

In all our wraparound provisions, we follow the school's Child Protection and Behaviour Policies which can be found on our school website.

A termly newsletter will be shared with parents and carers for you to see what your child(ren) has had access to.

Let's get...

Most of our activities will be split up under a title of 'Let's get....' These will be planned over a 3 week cycle. Our aim is to have an environment that is similar to our Early Years approach, which includes key areas that remain consistent and are enhanced throughout the year. They will also have resources they can choose to use independently and follow our approach 'Choose it, Use it, Put it away.



Other options

Our pupils have access to an amazing environment both inside and outside. The grounds include allotments, 2 large playgrounds, play equipment, field during drier periods, Forest School area, Rainforest (sensory space), dining room, hall space, library, children's kitchen, and other classrooms if needed.

Let's get...

Creative	Painting, cooking, drawing, colouring, junk modelling, clay, etc	Talking	Guided social opportunities including board games, circle times, mindfulness activities, sensory walks.
Active	A selection of structured activities included in the session such as yoga, multi skills, dance, access to Forest School area. This is in addition to full use of our outdoor spaces.	Chilling	Down time in the Rainforest room with bean bags, books, calming music, fiddle toys. This is a smaller room next to the main area.
Reading	Group visits to our school library to read independently, in small groups or story telling time.	Eco-minded	A focus on sustainability, how we can be eco-friendly and activities which improve our school grounds.
Cooking	Time to cook, learn to prepare food, plan for themed events, etc. Use produce from our allotments.	Thinking	Challenges to solve linked to curriculum areas such as Science, DT, English, Maths, etc.
Building	A range of construction activities such as hollow blocks, plus plus, lego, duplo, etc	Eating	Children will be encouraged to help themselves to food options (with adult guidance) and eat within the Restaurant like we do at lunch times.



We want our wraparound provision to be the best place for our pupils as possible. This means it will take time to build on our ideas, incorporate theirs and build up our resources and systems. We will update this space as we continue to develop.

7:45am arrival with options for breakfast such as cereal, fruit, toast. Activities are mapped out

across the week such as colouring, small world, crafts, construction, themed weeks. 8:45am children taken to classes.



Nursery Lunch Club

At the end of the nursery morning at 11:45am, children head to Strathmore Restaurant (dining room). They can have a hot meal, catered through HCL or bring a packed lunch.

Children head back to the nursery setting around 12:15pm and play with the resources in their provision to ensure they feel secure.







Children are collected from their classes at 3:15pm and taken to the dining room. They will have their cold option food which they help themselves to. If children go to after school clubs, they will be collected from the club at 4:15pm and have their food following this.

There are timetabled activities and also freedom to choose resources.

The outside space is free to use and the hall becomes available after 4:15pm. Our sessions finish at either 5:15pm or 5:45pm.


Children have access to a variety of fruit, cereals, toast, spreads and other cold snacks. Alternative dairy options can be provided at no extra cost. Please contact the school office to discuss.



Nursery Lunch Club

If your child chooses a hot meal option they will have a 3 week menu to choose from via HCL. Please visit their website via this link for example menu options.





Wraparound provision

The children will have access to a selection of cold foods such as wraps, sandwiches, breadsticks, meats, vegetables, fruit, dairy items, etc. The children are encouraged to access the Restaurant as a buffet style, helping themselves with guidance and support from staff. Children will eat in the restaurant before returning to activities. There will be two sittings. 3.30-4pm and 4.30pm - 5pm. The second session is mostly for children who are attending clubs first but children can choose to eat later if they wish. Please speak to the office if you have any dietary requirements.

FAQs



Will I need to rebook my child on each year?

No, once your child has a place at any of our provisions, it is theirs until they leave Strathmore or you inform the office you no longer require the provision.

My child has SEND needs. Will you be able to accommodate them?

All children are welcome. Please speak to the office so we can discuss options, consider staffing requirements if needed and training.



Can I use my 30 hours to attend nursery lunch club?

Yes. You can use 15 hours in the morning sessions, 5 hours for lunch provision and have 10 hours to use with another provider.



Do you offer any discounts?

If your child is entitled to Pupil
Premium funds you can have one
free session in one of our
wraparound provisions a week.
We do not currently offer sibling
discount.



Can my child attend a mixture of the after school sessions?

At this time, we ask for you to identify a best fit. If you need wraparound most days until 5:45pm then choose this option. For odd sessions, please speak to the main office so we can check staffing ratios.



Why do we need to pay in advance?

We need to ensure staffing ratios for each term and cover costs. Sessions cannot be refunded unless 48 hour notice has been given.
