Screening of Resilience film

Using the Pupil Equity Funding (PEF) we have begun to make partnerships with “New Solutions”. They are a newly formed company who will work with pupils, families and school staff to ensure that we are supporting and challenging all of our learners.

School staff will view the film from 3.30 – 5.00 pm as part of our ongoing in-house training. As part of our family learning, you are invited to attend the screening of “Resilience” on Wednesday 17 October from 6.00 – 7.45 pm in our gym hall.

“Resilience” is a one hour documentary that delves into the science of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACES). It explains that what happens to us as children can have a huge impact on our lives. We will provide childcare from “Party Wishes”. They will entertain our P1-3 learners with a Cowboy and Indian party, our P4-7 learners will be making slime! An alternative “Mindfulness” activity will be provided as a “quiet” activity. School staff have volunteered to assist to ensure that there are familiar faces present. Pizza and juice will be provided. There is no cost for attending the screening/party.
