<u>Maths</u> <u>Mixed number fractions</u>

This week, we have started our fractions unit. We have been learning about mixed number fractions and placing these on a number line. For their homework, children have a worksheet to continue practising this. If they need a refresher, there is a video they can watch (I will also put the link on Showbie).





## Equivalent fractions

I have also found a game so that children can use to practise building fractions, creating mixed numbers and create equivalent fractions (fractions that are equal to each other).

### Writing

This week, we have completed some work on **fronted adverbials** (sentence starters that tell us where, when or how). On Showbie, there is a worksheet for children to complete to see if they can add a phrase or word that tells the reader where, when or how.

They can look back at Wednesday's lesson (28th February) if they need a reminder of some of the ones we used in our writing. I mentioned to a few parents, I don't mind if they use dictation, type or write on Showbie, whichever they prefer.

## Spelling
