### Maths

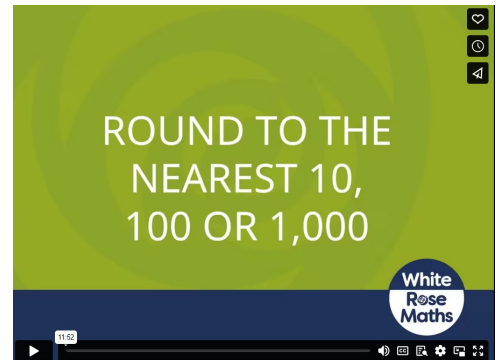
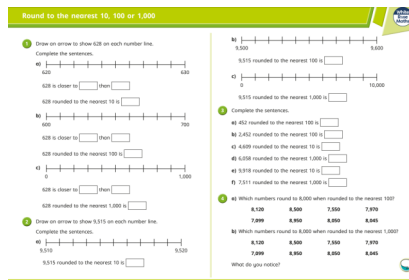
