had a great conversation in class, about the mistakes the chick had made and what they should have done at different points of the story. Children then completed a sheet

thinking about what they use the internet for, what they would change about the internet and who their trusted adults are if they have a problem.

I've asked them to design a poster/information sheet that helps children keep safe online. They can use some of the ideas from Chicken Clicking to help them.
