Writing

This week, we have started our new text of Our Tower by Joseph Coelho.

Suggested Writing Activity:

What do you think is going to happen in the story? Imagine you are one of the characters and write a diary entry (just like we did in class this week), but this time, continue the story

on. Did you travel through the estate to visit the tree that was gazing at you? What was the tree like? Was it magical? Use the success criteria on Showbie to see what you were able to include.



<u>Maths</u>

This week, we have practised different methods for multiplying multiples of 100 e.g. 4×700 . As an extra step, their homework this week is to multiply by 100.

Children should scan the QR code to watch the video before having a go at the work-sheet, unless they feel confident straight away, in which case they could use the video if they are stuck.





The answers for the homework will be uploaded on Showbie and Famly so that children can mark their answers straight away to see how they have got on.

Times Tables Rock Stars is on the iPads, which is something we would like the children to go on every night. This only needs to be for no longer than 5 minutes. Research has shown that practising on TT Rockstars for no more than 5 minutes a day is enough to further improve children's rapid recall.
