This week in Badgers we have been learning lots!

In Geography this week we looked at mountainous regions in the UK, and described their location to each other using geographical language.

In science, we started looking at magnets. We looked at the north and south poles of magnets and whether same and opposite poles attract or repel. We then investigated different materials to see if they were magnetic or not.

In art this week, we made our own paper using the same techniques as the Ancient Egyptians. We ripped strips of paper, coated them in watery PVA and layered the strips. Next week, we will create our scroll designs onto them.

<u>Maths</u>


