<u>Maths</u>

This week, we have practised different methods for multiplying 3 digit numbers by I digit numbers. On Showbie, there is a worksheet for children to complete, using any of the methods they are most confident with. (I've also uploaded a picture of the methods to remind them). There's also a video for them to watch if they need more of a refresher.



Writing

This term, our text is Our Tower by Joseph Coelho.

Suggested Writing Activity:

This week we've thought about character traits and writing speech to show those characters.

On Showbie, is a sheet with different people and a line they are saying. Can children write

the speech and punctuate it correctly, adding in the way it was said and maybe what the character was

doing when they said it?

Spelling

These are our spelling words for the next two weeks. We will still be doing the spelling tests each Friday. (the zhun sound spelt -sion) confusion, explosion, division, television, decision (Year 3 / 4 words) breathe, circle, different, extreme, fruit

On Showbie, I've added some cards that suggest different ways to practise spellings that children might find fun and useful.

<u>Multiplication</u>

Following on from the workshop, children will be able to continue practising on TT Rockstars, but for those looking for a bit of a change or different way to practise, there is a sheet with QR codes of different multiplication games. I've also uploaded the speed grid and the target boards onto Showbie. They should be able to use these every week, they will just need to get rid of their previous.
