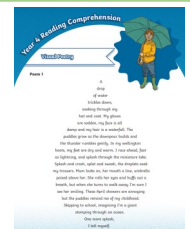

Reading

Due to swimming, we haven't be able to fit in our whole class reading sessions. For homework, I will set a reading comprehension sheet for children to read and have a go at answering.

If children are struggling, you can read it with them or read the questions, it doesn't need to be independent. During our whole class reading lessons, we would be working in small groups or pairs anyway.



Writing

We have been writing 'add on' poems this week. I know that some of the children really enjoyed this, so they could have a go at writing their own over the break. It could be set in the ocean, it could be set on a mountain, in a volcano etc. I will upload the scaffold we used to help them if they'd like to write it.

Spelling

Here are our spellings for the next two weeks—you might notice some repeats as we have had less time to practise them in school due to swimming. We also didn't do our Friday tests for this reason.
