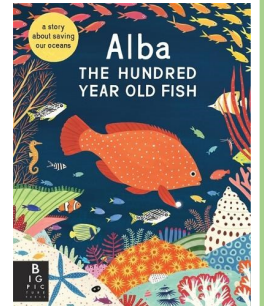
Singular	Plural

Writing

This term, our text is *Alba: The Hundred Year Old Fish* by Lara Hawthorne.

Suggested Writing Activity:

As mentioned, last week, we practised writing apostrophes for possession (e.g. *The boy's book*). We also practised apostrophes for possession when the word is a plural (more than one) word (e.g. *The lions' food*).



There is a booklet for children to complete with 6 worksheets – most children will have completed some of the sheets last week, but I have uploaded it again so they can complete the others. There's also a powerpoint to help remind them.
