PE

In PE children will be completing units on gymnastics and Outdoor and Adventurous activities.

PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Being me In My World'. It's about rules, rights and responsibilities.

English Reading

In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- Here We Are
- Leon and The Place Between
- Traction Man

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'Coming To England' by Floella Benjamin. The main writing outcome of this unit will be a recount. During this unit children will also focusing on the following grammar and

Coming to

England

- Paragraphs
- Prepositions
- Inverted commas to punctuation speech.

Maths

In maths this half term, children will start with a unit on Place Value to 1000. they will look at building and partitioning numbers and fully understanding how they are made up (identifying thousands, hundreds, tens and ones).

They will also start their unit on addition and subtraction, where they will learning and practising using the formal written method for both. They will also look at solving multi-step word problems involving addition and subtraction.

Science

In science children will complete a unit of work on Movement and Nutrition. They will learn about the human skeleton and be able to identify some bones. They will look at muscles within the body and how they change with movement. They will also look at what constitutes a balanced diet.

History

In history this half term, children will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. They will be answering the over arching question "How did Ancient Egypt change over time?" Within the unit they will learn about how Egypt was ruled, architecture, religion and beliefs as well as the arts.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will be learning about Rivers. They will be answering the over arching question "How do rivers, people and land effect each other?" Within the unit they will learn about the journey of a river from source to mouth. This will include processes along the river such as erosion and deposition.

<u>RE</u>

In RE, the children will be focussing on the Hindu story of Rama and Sita.

Computing

In computing, children will be completing the 'iSafe' unit where they look at staying safe online.

Design and Technology

In Design and Technology the children will be completing a unit on Cooking and Nutrition. They will look at seasonal food and how it can be used to cook. They will be creating a recipe for and cooking their own vegetable tart.

<u>Music</u>

In music, children will be learning to play the Ukulele as a class.

<u>French</u>

In French, children will be learning about French greetings. <u>Value or</u> <u>Trait</u>
