PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Being me In My World'. Its about rules, rights and responsibilities.

English Reading

For the first half of year 2, the children will be continuing with Little Wandle Phonics, reading practise sessions.

During these sessions children will continue to build and revise their phonics knowledge and use this to decode and read books matched to their phonics learning. Within these reads, they will focus on decoding, prosody, comprehension, as well as identifying new vocabulary.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'Troll Swap' by Leigh Hodgkinson. The main writing outcome of this unit will be an adventure story. During this unit children will also focusing on the following grammar and punctuation:



- Capital letters and full stops.
- Expanded noun phrases.
- Using 'because' and 'and' for subordination.

Maths

In maths this half term, children will start with a unit on Place Value to 100. They will look at building and partitioning numbers and fully understanding how they are made up and the value of each digit in these numbers.

They will also start their unit on addition and subtraction, where they will be starting to learn to use a formal written method for these calculations. They will also look at solving multi-step word problems.



Science

In science children will complete a unit of work on living things and their habitats. They will look at life processes and learn to classify objects into alive, was once alive and has never been alive. We will also look at food chains and learn how living things eat each other for energy to grow.



History

In history this half term, children will be learning about Life in Stuart England. They will learn about the Great Plague, and how it affected people in London. They will learn about The Great Fire of London. They will learn about how and where it started and why it was so devastating. They will also learn about Samuel Pepys and his diary.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will be learning about what it is like to live in the mountains. They will complete a study on Keswick in the lake district, learning about what it is like to live there focussing on transport and tourism. They will think about why people choose to live in or visit mountainous areas.

Music

In music, children will be learning about West African call and response songs.

Design and Technology

In Design and Technology the children will be completing a unit on Structures. They will be looking at what 3D shapes are strong and stable and would make good structures. They will be designing and making a chair for Baby Bear from Goldilocks and the Three bears.



RE

In RE children will be learning about Christianity and how Christians show kindness.

Computing

Children will be completing the 'iProgram' unit where they will learn to use visual programming language.
