In PE children will be completing units on gymnastics and Outdoor and Adventurous activities.

<u>Curriculum Map—Autumn I</u>



The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Being me In My World'. Its about rules, rights and responsibilities.

English Reading

For the first half term of Year I, the children will start by recapping and revisiting Phase 3 and 4 phonics, to ensure they are secure in these areas. The children will then move onto learning Phase 5

phonics (alternate GPCs). They will learn ay (play), ou (cloud) and ea (each).

Further to this, the children will also complete three reads a week using books linked to their phonics knowledge. They will focus on decoding, prosody, comprehension, as well as identifying new vocabulary.

<u>Science</u>

Sector -

In science children will complete a unit of work on Seasonal Changes. They will learn about the four seasons and the weather associated with them. They will explore how seasonal changes affect trees, daylight hours and clothing choices. They will plan and carry out their own weather report.

<u>Music</u>

In music, children will be learning about pulse and rhythm.

Computing

In computing, children will be completing the 'iSafe' unit where they look at staying safe online.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is "Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. The main writing outcome of this unit will be an adventure story. During this unit children will also focusing on the following grammar and



- punctuation:
 Combining words to make sentences.
- Beginning to use capital letters and full stops in sentences and capital letters for names and I.

<u>History</u>

In history this half term, children will be learning about how we find out about the past from photographs. They will learn about people, houses and our local area using photographs from the recent past. They will learn about photographs being a secondary source. They will also learn about how cameras have changed throughout history.

Design and Technology

In Design and Technology the children will be completing a unit on Structures. Children will learn about different types of windmills and what they are used for. They will learn about the key features of windmills and how they work. They



will design and make their own working windmill <u>Maths</u>

In maths this half term, children will start with a unit on Place Value to 10. This will involve writing, ordering and comparing rumbers to 10 as well as gaining fluency of rumber bonds to 10.



They will also start to learn about addition and subtraction to 20. Within this unit, they will add by counting on and using number bonds, making addition and subtraction stories, solving subtractions by crossing out and solving picture problems.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will be learning about what it is like to live in a city. They will learn about the human and physical features that can be found in a city. They will also compare Lichfield as a city to Birmingham, looking at similarities and differences.
