PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Celebrating Difference'. Its about kindness and resolving conflict.

English Reading

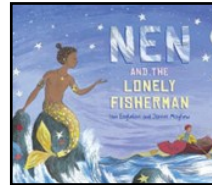
In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- Traction Man (continued)
- Hansel and Gretel
- The Polar express

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

English Writing

Poetry – we will be looking at poetry called 'Dance with me Autumn' by a collection of poets. We will be identifying the features and vocabulary choice within poems.



The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'Nen and the Lonely Fisherman' by Ian Eagleton and James Mayhew. The main writing outcome of this unit is a fantasy story.

Grammar features this term include using conjunctions, adverbs, using and or a, and inverted commas.

Maths

This term, they will start their unit on multiplication and division. They will be focusing on learning their 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. Then starting to learn a formal written method for multiplying and dividing 2 digit numbers.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will be learning about Mountains. They will be answering the over arching question "How do mountains interact with what is around them?" Within the unit they will learn the difference with a mountain and hill. How humans have adapted to living on mountains and how a mountain's conditions change.

Science

In science children will complete a unit of work on Forces and Magnets. Children will learn about push and pull forces and friction. Children will also learn about different types of magnets. They will learn what materials are magnetic and which are not.

History

In history this half term, children will be learning about the Cradles of Civilisation. They will be answering the over arching question "How similar and different were Ancient Egypt and Ancient Sumer?" Within the unit they will learn about Mesopotamia and compare how it was ruled, the architecture and arts to Ancient Egypt.

Art and Design

In Art and Design the children will be completing a unit on Craft and Design. The children will be learning about Ancient Egyptian scrolls and they will make their own paper, to create their very own Egyptian scroll.

RE

In RE, the children will be focussing on what Hindu's learn from the stories of Vishnu.

Computing

In computing, children will be completing the unit 'iProgram'. They will code using scratch.

Music

In music, children will be learning to play the Ukulele as a class.

French

In French, children will be learning about colours, size, shape.
