PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Celebrating Difference'. It's about accepting ourself and others.

English Reading

In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- Romans on the Rampage
- The Roman Diary—The Journal of Iliona
- The Polar Express

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'Greek Myths' by Jean Menzies. The main writing outcome of this unit will be a fiction text. During this unit children will also

focus on the following grammar and punctuation:


- Paragraphs
- Conjunctions to express time, place and cause
- Sentence structures
- Fronted adverbials

Maths

In maths this half term, children will have a large unit on multiplication and division. They will start by practising counting in 6s, 7s and 9s, then move on to multiplying by 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12. They will then look at dividing by 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12.

The second part of the unit is around written methods for multiplication and division. This will include the long multiplication method, which they are familiar with as well as division with and without remainders.

Science



History

In history this half term, children will be building on their knowledge of the Romans and learning about how they became an empire. We will learn about Augustus Caesar, Julius Caesar and Pompeii. Our big historical questions is 'What can sources reveal about Roman way of life?'

Geography

In geography this half term, children will learn about population. They will learn about how and why population distribution varies across Great Britain. Children will focus on and compare Cardiff and London. They will learn about multiculturalism and how it is shown in these two cities.

<u>RE</u>

In RE children will learn about Christianity and how Christians express their beliefs at Christmas.

Computing

In computing, children will be completing an 'iProgram' unit using Scratch.

Art & Design

In Art & Design, the children will be completing a unit on textile techniques. This will follow nicely from their DT unit in Autumn I, and will allow children to create stunning visual art inspired by the striking colours, patterns and textures of bird and insect life.

Music

In music, children will be learning about body and tuned percussion.

<u>French</u>

In French, children will be learning the names for clothes.
