We have had a super week in Badgers class this week.

In geography, we have learnt about how farming can change the landscape. We have looked at the planting of hedges and the building of fences, draining marshland and planting forests and the impact this has on the landscape.

In art this week, we have had a great time using our observational drawing skills and shading skills to draw some detailed drawings of flowers. However this week, we zoomed in and drew only part of the flower in more detail. We then added colour using watercolour paints.

In science we have continued our topic on light and shadows. We have been investigating shadows. We learnt that we can change the size and length of a shadow by alterin the position of the torch. For instance, we learnt that if you put the torch closer, the shadow gets bigger.

For your English homework this week, you need to complete some reading comprehension. Please read the text really carefully and then answer the questions about it.


Remember to answer the questions fully. Re-read the question and then your answer, to check that it makes
