PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Dreams and Goals'. We will learn about creating achievable goals.

English Reading

In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- Voices in the Park
- The Roman Diary—The Journal of Iliona

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'Our Tower' by Joseph Coelho. The main writing outcome of this unit will be a recount text. During this unit children will also focus on the following grammar and punctuation:



- Verb forms (progressive and present perfect).
- Paragraphs
- Punctuating direct speech
 - Fronted adverbials

Maths

In maths this half term, children will have complete the rest of the further multiplication and division unit, This will include the long multiplication method, which they are familiar with as well as division with and without remainders.

We will then move onto statistics, and interpreting data. Children will be able to draw and read line graphs, as well as recap their understanding of pictograms and bar graphs.

Science

In science, children will be completing a unit in chemistry, focusing on states of matter. Children will investigate the properties of solids, liquids and gases. Children will use their knowledge of the water cycle, and learn about the relationship between temperature and rate of evaporation.

History

In history this half term, children will use their prior knowledge and new learning to answer the big question 'What changed in Roman Britain?' The unit will focus on what Romans brought to Britain, their encounters with the different tribes and Boudicca, as well as the layout of Roman towns and cities.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will learn about coastal processes and landforms. They will learn about the processes that take place around the coast and how this affects the land. Children will learn about the Jurassic coast, coastal habitats and the coast of west Wales.

<u>RE</u>

In RE children will learn about Christianity and the life and teachings of Jesus.

Computing

In computing, children will be completing an 'iAnimate' unit to create computer animations.

Design & Technology

In Design & Technology, children will be exploring pavilion structures. They will learn about what they are used for and investigate how to create strong and stable structures, before designing and creating their own pavilions, complete with cladding.

Music

In music, children will be learning about haiku music and performance.
