PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is Dreams and Goals. Children will learn about being perseverant, group co-operation and sharing success.

English Reading

During Spring I of year 2 children will continue with Little Wandle Fluency. This is a new scheme in which children gain the skills and confidence to become fluent readers. This will also be paired with Little Wandle 'Bridge to Spelling', where children will be taught the foundational skills for spelling.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'The Dragon Machine' by Helen Ward. The main outcome of this text is to write an adventure story with a change of character. During this unit children will also be focusing on the following punctuation and grammar.

- -Write sentences with different forms.
- -Use subordination
- -Use present and past tenses correctly and consist-D Ω ently
- Machine -Use punctuation correctly exclamation marks, question marks.

Maths

In maths this half term, children will continue our unit on length, learning to measure and compare in metres and centimetres. We will then move on to a unit on mass, learning about mass in the context of kilograms and grams.

Science

In science children will complete a unit of work on Materials properties and changes. Reflecting on their knowledge of different materials, children will begin to explain why materials are used in certain contexts. They will develop enquiry skills to investigate the properties of materials and explore the science of inventing new ones.

<u>History</u>

In history this half term, children will be learning about Children's Lives in Victorian Britain. They will learn how most poor children had to work for a living, the types of jobs children had and what school was like for Victorian children. They will then go on to compare life for children in the Victorian Era compared to now.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will study places within the UK and other countries within Europe (France, Spain, Italy). They will learn about methods of travel and how we can use maps to create routes and locate places.

Music

In music, children will complete the topic 'Musical Me' using percussion instruments.

Computing

In computing, children will be completing the 'iSearch' unit, learning how to use the internet.

Design and Technology

In Design and Technology children will be designing and creating their own Ferris Wheel, considering how the different components fit together so that the wheels rotate and the structure stands freely. Children will select appropriate materials and develop their cutting and joining skills.
