



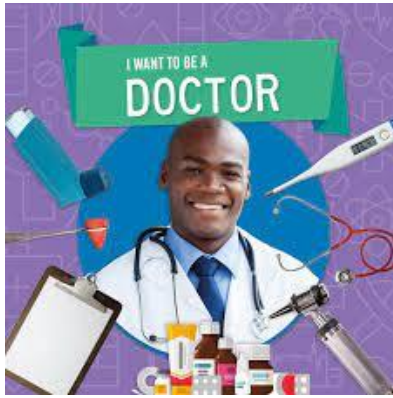
Below are some home learning suggestions, please upload any home learning onto **Famly**.

Can you retell the story of Doctor Mani and Toney?

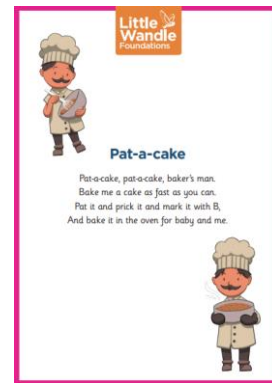
Nursery Rhyme of the Week
