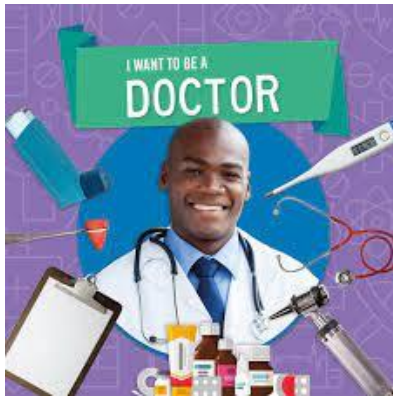
Another amazing week in Daffodils.
