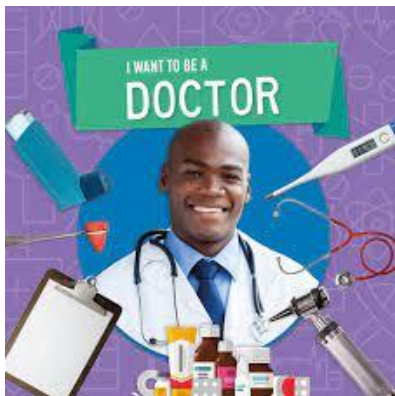
Below are some home learning suggestions, please upload any home learning onto **Family**.

What happened to them?

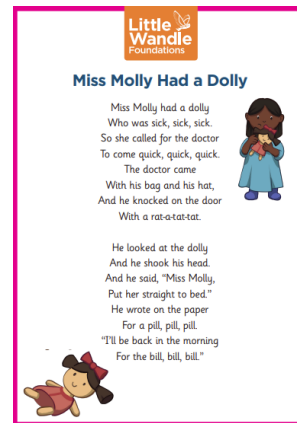
Nursery Rhyme of the Week

The children have really enjoyed this week's nursery rhyme. They've all joined in with the actions.

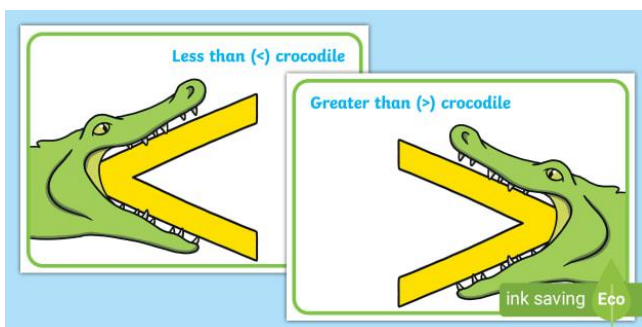
Can you sing our nursery rhyme of the week?
