PSHE

The theme for this half term in PSHE is 'Healthy Me'. We will learn about healthy friendships and inner strength.

English Reading


In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be reading the following texts:

- River poems
- Firework
- Wild Robot

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'Wisp: A Story of Hope' by Zana Frailon. The main writing outcome of this unit will be fiction piece writing from the character's point of view. Children will also focus on the following:



- Expanded noun phrases.
- Nouns and pronouns to avoid repetition.
- Inverted commas for speech.
- Fronted adverbials.

Maths

In maths this half term, children will complete the rest of their statistics unit, drawing and reading different graphs. We will then move onto fractions. Children will learn about mixed number fractions and build on their knowledge of equivalent fractions. Children will also learn about improper fractions. They will then use this knowledge to simplify fractions, as well as adding and subtracting fractions. Towards the end of the half-term, we will start our unit of Time.



Science

In science, children will be completing a unit in physics, focusing on sound and vibration. Children will explore different ways of producing sounds and the relationship between vibrations and what they hear. They will understand more about echolocation.

History

In history this half term, children will learn about Christianity in the three empires, where they will hear about persecution of Christians by the Roman Empire, the changes that Emperor Constantine made, and the Byzantine and Aksum Empires.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will learn about tourism. They will be answering the big question of how do tourists interact with a place? They will learn about the seaside, types of tourism, mountain adventures and summer in the sun.

RE

In RE children will learn about Christianity and the death and resurrection of Jesus.

Computing

In computing, children will be completing an 'iMail' unit to send and receive emails responsibly.

Art & Design

In Art and Design, children will be using everyday electrical items as a starting point, to develop awareness of composition in drawing. They will then combine media for effect, and develop their drawings into prints.



Music

In music, children will be learning about music inspired by the Romans.

French

In French, children will be learning to say numbers.
