PSHE

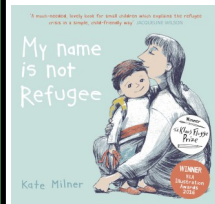
The theme for this half term in PSHE is Healthy Me. Children will learn about making healthier choices, nutrition and relaxation.

English Reading

During Spring 2 of year 2 children will continue with Little Wandle Fluency. This is a new scheme in which children gain the skills and confidence to become fluent readers. This will also be paired with Little Wandle spelling where children will be taught the foundational skills for spelling.

English Writing

The text we will be focussing on in our writing lessons is 'My name is not Refugee' The main outcome of this text is to write a fiction recount from a characters point of view. During this unit children will also be focusing on the following punctuation and grammar.



- Use the progressive form of verbs in the present and past tense.
- Use subordination (apply because, when; introduce (so) that).
- Use present and past tenses correctly and consistently.
- Use punctuation correctly – apostrophes for the possessive.

Maths

In maths this half term, children will look at the following topics:

- word problems
- money

We will also spend some time at the start of the term revisiting some previous topics to ensure the children are confident.



Science



In science children will complete a unit of work on Animals including humans and lifecycles. We will study the lifecycles of various animals, learning what animals need to survive and how they change over time. Children will collect data that allows them to observe changes in their peers, while also developing their ability to take measurements and record data.

History

In history this half term, children will be learning about Great Change Makers. They will look at people from the past who have made a significant change and impact on our lives today. We will learn about these people, their place in history and changes over time.

Geography

In geography this half term, children will study Nature All Around Us. Children will learn about the physical features of different location and places within the UK and a country outside of Europe (Australia). They will develop their knowledge of plants and animals that live in these locations.

Music

In music, children will complete the topic 'Space' looking at dynamics, timbre, temp and motifs.

Art

In Art children will be developing their colour mixing skills, learning about the work of artist Romare Bearden and creating textured papers using paint. Children will compose collages inspired by their exploration of colour and texture in the world around them.



RE

In RE children will be learning about Christianity: Is it true that Jesus came back to live again?

Computing

In computing, children will be completing the 'iAnimate' unit. We will be exploring stop frame animation through story telling.
