# Curriculum Map – Spring 2

## PSHE

The theme in PSHE is 'Healthy Me'. Children will think about how they can stay safe and take care of their bodies emotionally and physically.

## English Reading

In our whole class reading sessions this half term, the children will be focusing on a variety of different texts including fiction and non-fiction.

They will be answering a variety of questions about these texts thinking about retrieval, inference, prediction, summarising and vocabulary skills.

## English Writing

During this half term children will be focusing on a range of different stimuli, including books and short clips, to engage them in writing different text types. They will look to independently include a range of writing techniques including;

- Formal and Informal
- Semi-colons
- Parenthesis
- Colons

## Maths

In maths this half term, children will be learning all about geometry focusing on area and perimeter, volume and position and movement. They will also be looking at algebra, reading data from graphs and negative numbers.

## Science

In science children will complete the unit Electricity, focusing on batteries, circuits and switches. Within this unit they will learn about the function of key components within an electrical circuit alongside understanding what voltage means and how it can affect a bulb.

## History

In history this half term, children will be learning about Abel Haywood. Within the unit they will be answering the over arching question of 'What can one mans story reveal about a city?' where they will be learning about changes that happened in Manchester and Britain.

## Geography

In geography this half term, children will be exploring Ethiopia and answering the overarching question 'How do global changes affect local places in Ethiopia'. Within this children will be learning about Ethiopia including what it was like in the past versus present and what the climate is like there.



## Computing

In computing, children will be completing the 'iApp' unit, looking at designing and developing apps.

## Art and Design

In Art and Design the children will be looking at the topic Photo Opportunity'. They will be exploring creative photographic techniques, using these to help them recreate a famous painting.

Children will learn about pop art, considering theme and variations.
