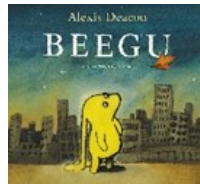

English Reading

We will continue to learn phase 5 alternate GPCs. They will learn sounds such as au/oor/al (dinosaur, floor, talk). Further to this, the children will also complete three reads a week using books linked to their phonics knowledge. They will focus on decoding, prosody, comprehension, fluency, as well as identifying new vocabulary.

English Writing

Comparing Animals - Studying both local and global animals, children recognise common features and use this information to make comparisons and begin to classify animals. They develop their understanding of classification by comparing the dietary habits of different animals and use their knowledge and imaginations to take on the role of a zookeeper.



History

Stories About the Past

Children will learn about different stories from the past. They will learn about how life has changed.
